



In Pursuance of An Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania Passed the 24th day of February 1785 "intituled" "an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation = Lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honorable the Supreme Executive Council I have surveyed on the 16th day of November 1785 the above described Tract of Two Hundred Acres of Land and allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads &c. No CC.VII situate in district No. 1. on the west side of the Alleganey River in the County of Westmoreland.
