And by Order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honble the Supreme Executive Council I have surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785. the above discribed Tract of five hundred Acres of land an allowance of six p Cent. for Roads &c No V. Situate in District No. 1. on the west side of the Alleganey River in Westmoreland County.
