



The above is a Draught of a Survey, made August 11th. 1826, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry Gregg, dated July 25th. 1826 for five Acres of land, but Contains four Acres and 118 perches of Six per Cent for highways, situate on the west side of the Monongahala River, in Pike Run Township W. County. At the time of Survey there was no improvement on the above land, there had been a Cabin built on it about 26 years ago but there is nothing of it now to be seen.
