



The above is a draught of a tract of land, called Defiance surveyed 25th February 1816, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Daniel L. Goble for fifteen acres, dated February 2^d 1816. Situate in Morris township in the county of Washington containing fourteen acres and fifty five perches together with the usual Allowance of six per cent. There is no resident settlement on this land, but a part of which has been improved for a number of years. There are no adverse claims.
