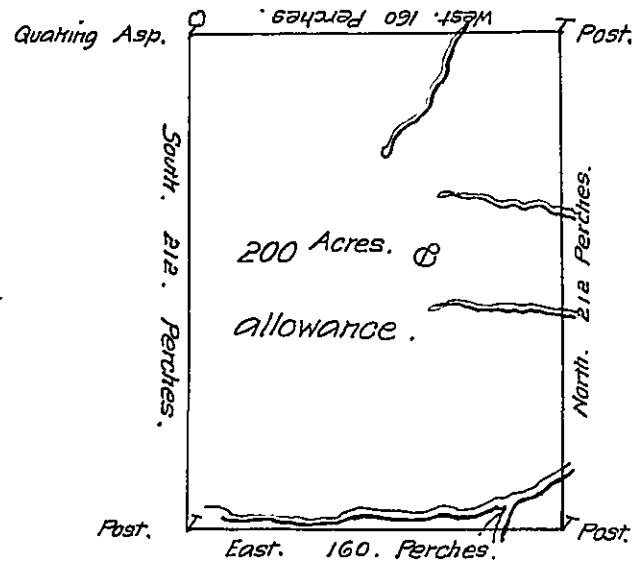

Cent for roads &c<sup>o</sup> was Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785. by
