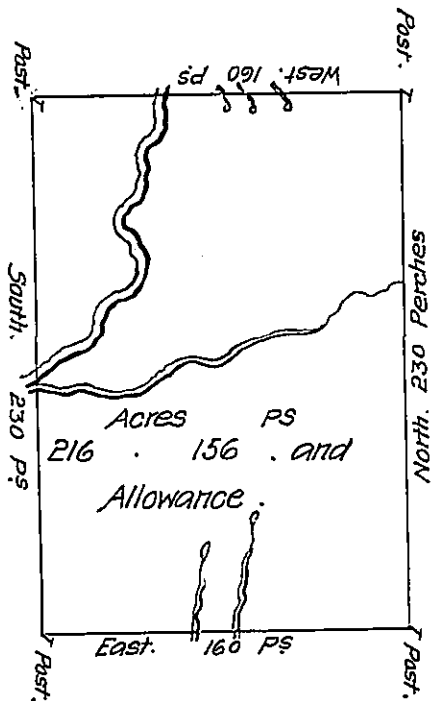


Part of District N^o 3.

In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain lands therein Mentioned And by Virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and Seal of Office from John Lutens Esq^r Surveyor Gen^l for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22nd day of August 1783. The Above tract of land Containing two hundred Sixteen Acres and 156 Perches and Allowance of 6 P. Cent. for Roads &c. Was Surveyed on the 8th day of June 1785 by
