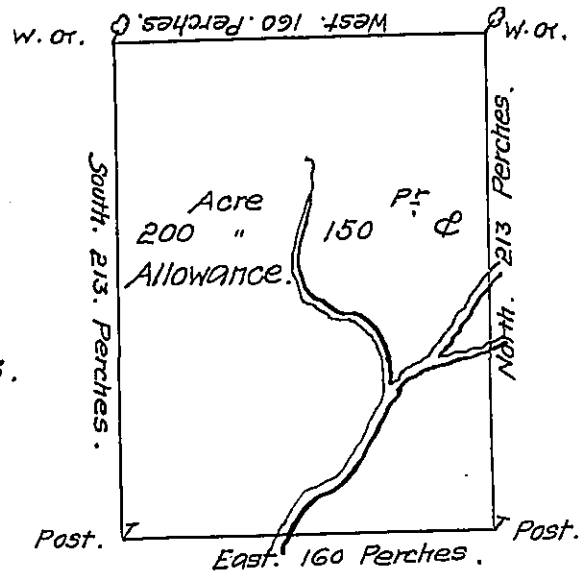


Part of District N<sup>o</sup> 3.



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of Certain lands therein Mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Luters Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to Me Directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1785. The above tract of Land Containing two hundred acres and one hundred and fifty perches and the Allowance of Six P<sup>t</sup> Cent for Roads &c<sup>a</sup> was Surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of June 1785 by
