



In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein Mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Luters Esquire Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to me directed bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1783 the Above tract of Land containing two hundred and fifty Six acres Ninety five Perches & allowance of Six P<sup>ts</sup> Cent for Roads & Co.
