



A Draught of a Survey called "Blackwood" situate on the Waters of Chartiers Cr. in Washington County Peter's Towns. Contain<sup>g</sup> 199 A.S. 75 P.S. and the usual Allow<sup>ce</sup> for Roads &c. executed Jan<sup>y</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> 1789 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Adam Gillfillen for 250 A.S. dated Sept. 13<sup>th</sup> 1788.

He requests to enter a Caveat against this Survey, and that in issuing the Citation he may have Ninety days Notice to prepare for Tryal as he lives near 1000 Miles from Phil<sup>a</sup> Viz. at the Falls of the Ohio.
