



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Marlborough Town-  
 ship in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania Being Part  
 of a large Tract that was formerly Surveyed to Dietrich Welker By Warrant  
 Dated the 17<sup>d</sup> May Anno. 1751. And was afterwards by Virtue of a Warrant  
 of Resurvey Dated at Philadelphia on the 21<sup>d</sup> June Anno. 1768. resurvey-  
 ed to him: The Said Dietrich Welker who by his Deed Poll dated the  
 29<sup>d</sup> September Anno. 1773. Sold and Conveyed his Right to the above Part  
 thereof unto Yost Martin Containing Fifty Two Acres and 120 Perches of  
 Land together with the usual allowance at Six per Cent for Roads  
 Formerly Surveyed and now Drawn for the said Yost Martin  
 By Order of the Surveyor General on the 15<sup>d</sup> April Anno. 1774
