



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September 1749 Resurveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1794 the above described Tract of Land Situate partly in Windsor and partly in Maiden creek Township in the County of Berks, Containing 104<sup>ac</sup> 130<sup>rs</sup> and the Allowance of six p<sup>cs</sup> Ct for Roads &<sup>ca</sup>. Taken from Thomas Lightfoot's Field Works the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1800.
