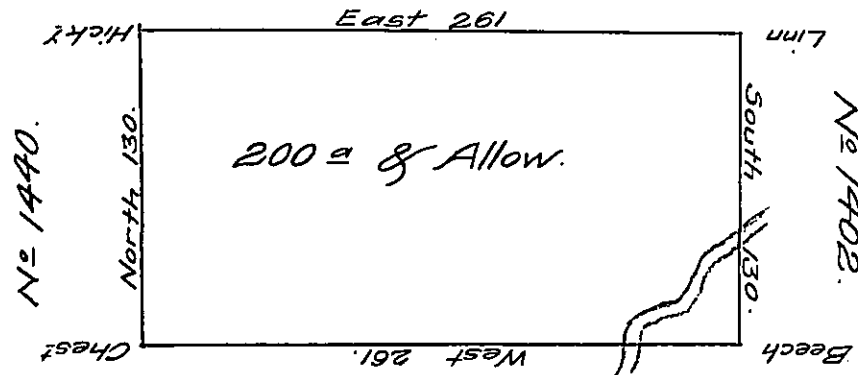

In pursuance of an act of Gen^l Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1785. Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen^l with the Aprobation of the Hon^{le} the Executive Council I have surveyd on the 16th day of Aug^t 1785 the above described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 ^{per} Cent for roads &c. N^o MCCCCXXXI situate in Dist. N^o 7 on the West side of the Alleg^y river in the County of Westmorland.
