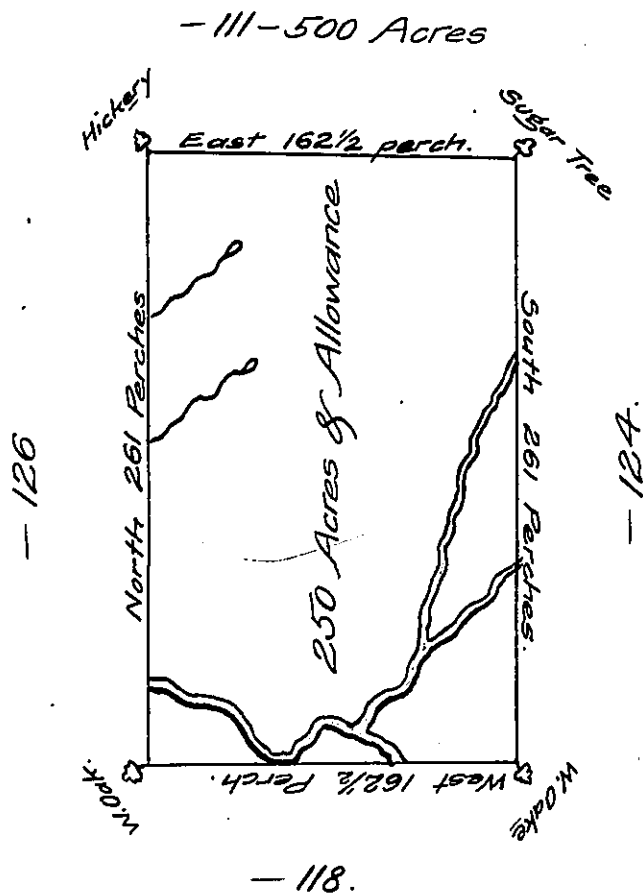


DONATION LANDS in DISTRICT N^o 6

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty fourth day of February 1785, entitled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth' & by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the Sixth Day of December 1785 the above described Tract of Two hundred & Fifty Acres of Land and allowance of six per Cent. for roads &c. N^o 125. Situate in District N^o 6 on the West side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmorland
