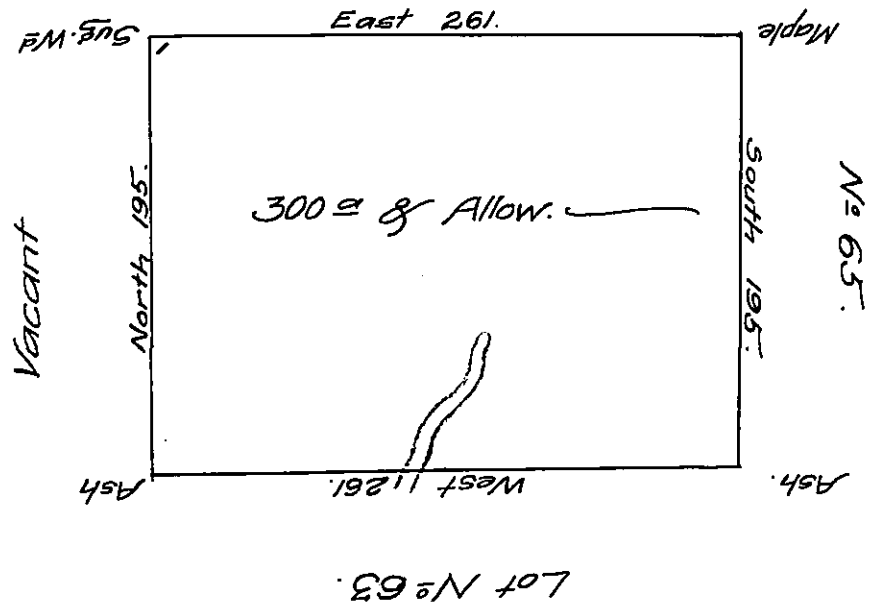

In pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the approbation of the Hon<sup>le</sup> Executive Council I have surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1785 the above described tract of three Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. No. LXIV situate in Dist. N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the County of Westmorland
