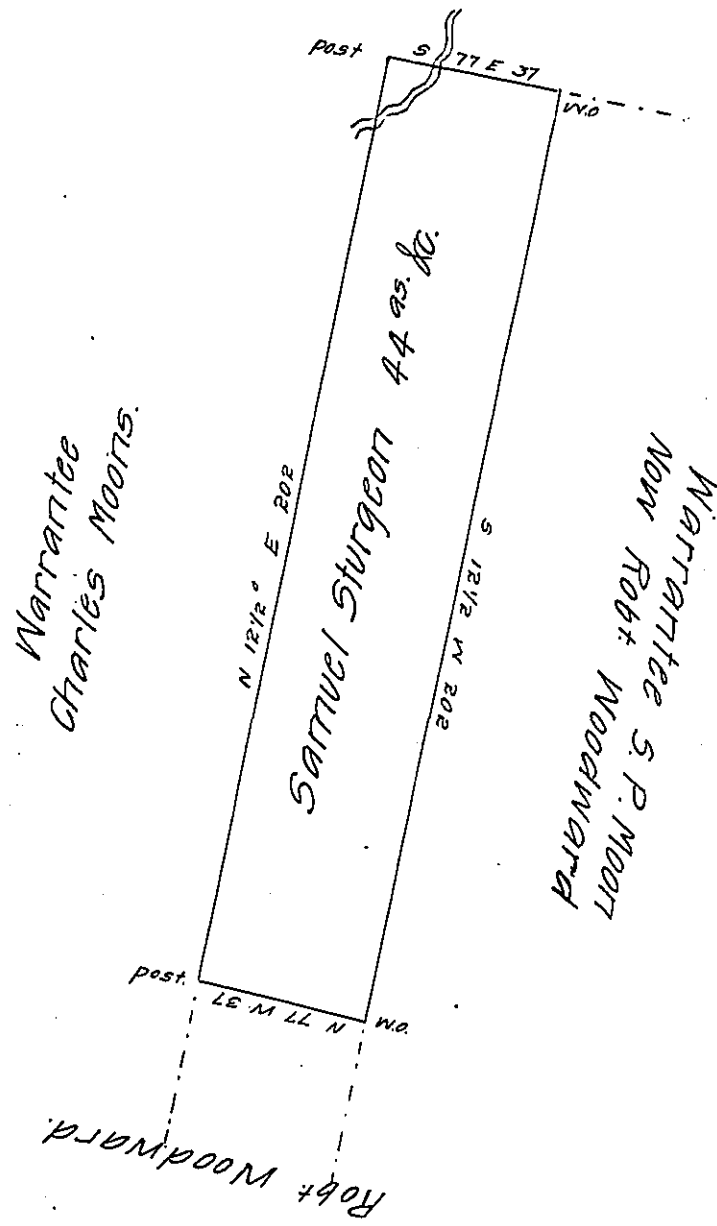


Warrantee G. Smith



In pursuance of A Warrant dated March 27th 1857. Granted to Samuel Sturgeon.

Surveyed to the same on the 27th April 1857. The above described tract of land containing forty four acres and allowance of six per cent. Situate in Plum creek township Armstrong County Adjoining Lands on the north warranted in the name of G. Smith on the east in the name of S. P. Moor, on the west in the name of G. Moor, and on the south Vacant Land in the name of Robt Woodward.
