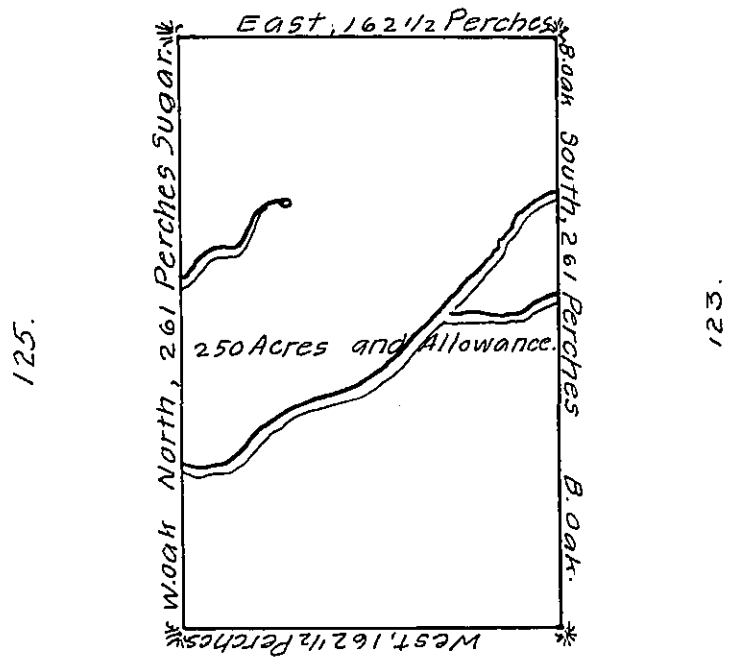

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth' and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive-Council, I have surveyed on the seventh Day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per cent. for Roads, &c. No. 124 situate in District No. 6, on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
