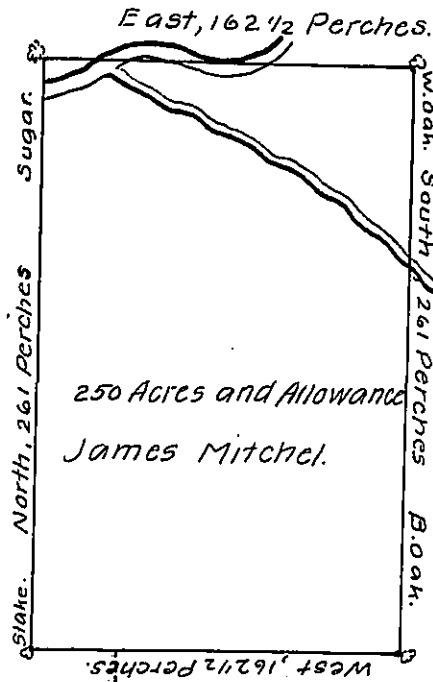

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intituled, 'An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation-Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth; and by Order of the Surveyor-General, with the Approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the Sixth Day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads, &c. No. 117 situate in District No. 6, on the West side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
