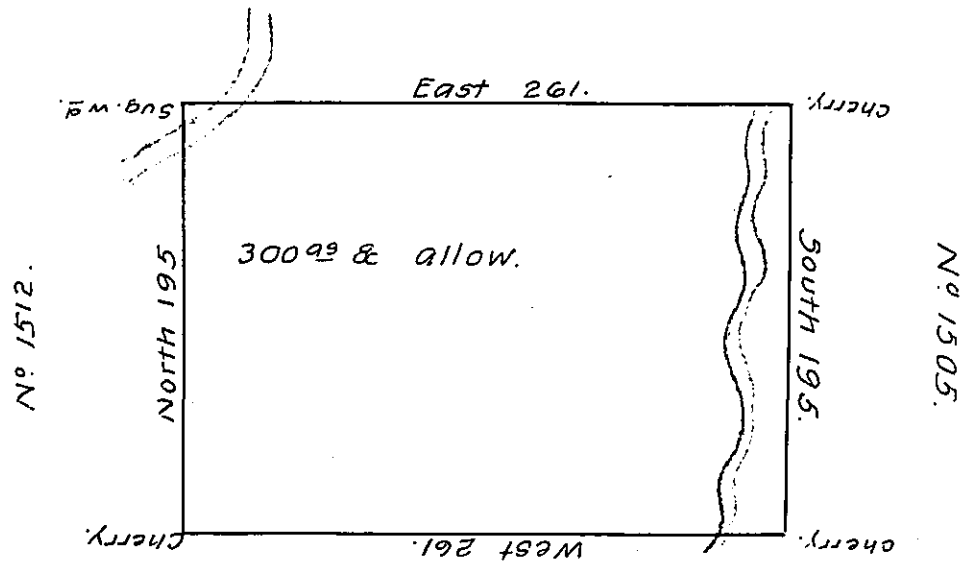

In pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the state of Pennsylv<sup>nia</sup> passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>ruary</sup> 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>le</sup> Executive Council I have surveyed on 6<sup>th</sup> day of Sep<sup>r</sup> 1785 the above D<sup>e</sup>scribed tract of Three Hund<sup>d</sup> Acres & Allow. of 6 & Cent. for Roads &c. No<sup>o</sup> LXIX situate in Dist<sup>r</sup> No<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup>. River in the County of Westmorland.
