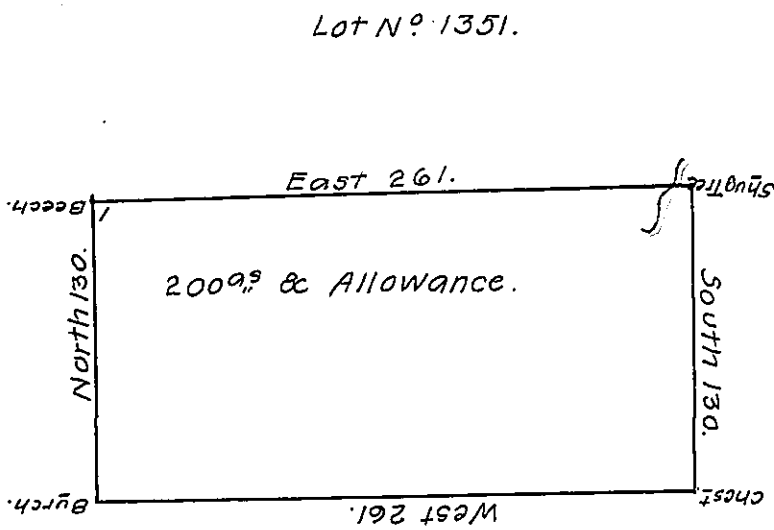


Catherine, The Widow of Mark

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of Feb^y, 1785 Intituled an Act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this state & by order of the surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^e the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 16th day of July 1785 the above Described tract of two-Acres & Allow. of 6 ⁷/₈ Cent. for roads &c. N° MCCCCL situate in District N° 7 on the west side of the Allegeny river in the County of Westmorland.
