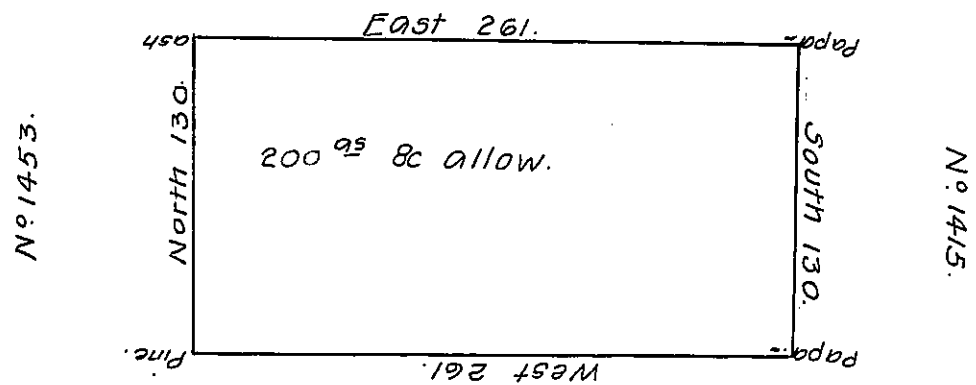

In pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of ~~of~~ this Commonwealth & by Order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>le</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred acres & Allow. of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent. for roads & N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCXVIII. situate in Dist. N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Alleg<sup>x</sup> river in the County of Westmorland
