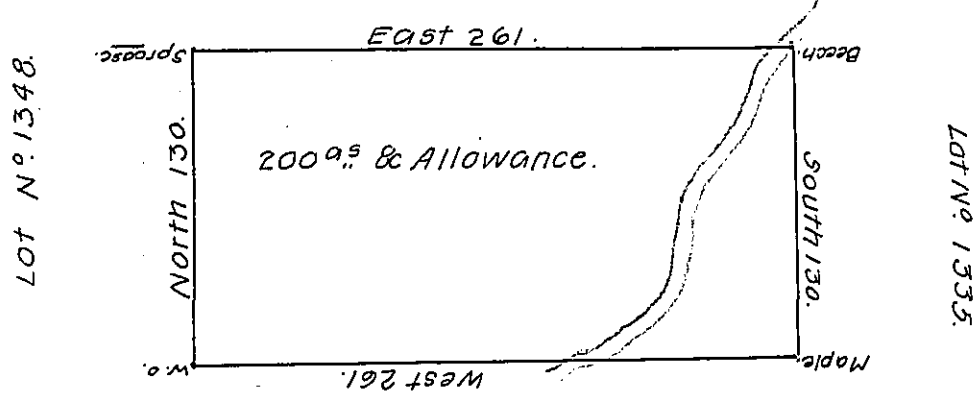

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an Act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent. for roads &c N<sup>o</sup> MCCCX situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the west side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmorland.
