



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Montgomery Township Franklin County containing one hundred & sixty four Acres & forty eight perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 14th of November 1815 under the direction of Archibald Fleming then Deputy Surveyor of said County, in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Rowen bearing date the 2nd day of June 1814, as appears by a Draft thereof filed in my Office; which I have examined & find correct; Certified this 4th day of June 1833.

Note that part of the above Survey marked A. containing 78 a. 81 p. & al. separated from the rest of the tract by a dotted line, appears to be included in a Survey made 21st May 1817 on a Warrant to Jane Rankin for 400 a. bearing date 1st of April 1794, and claimed by the owners of said Rankin Warrant. Note A house ^{and standing} had been built at the place marked O said to have been done by mistake & Grain had been raised on another part of the Survey.
