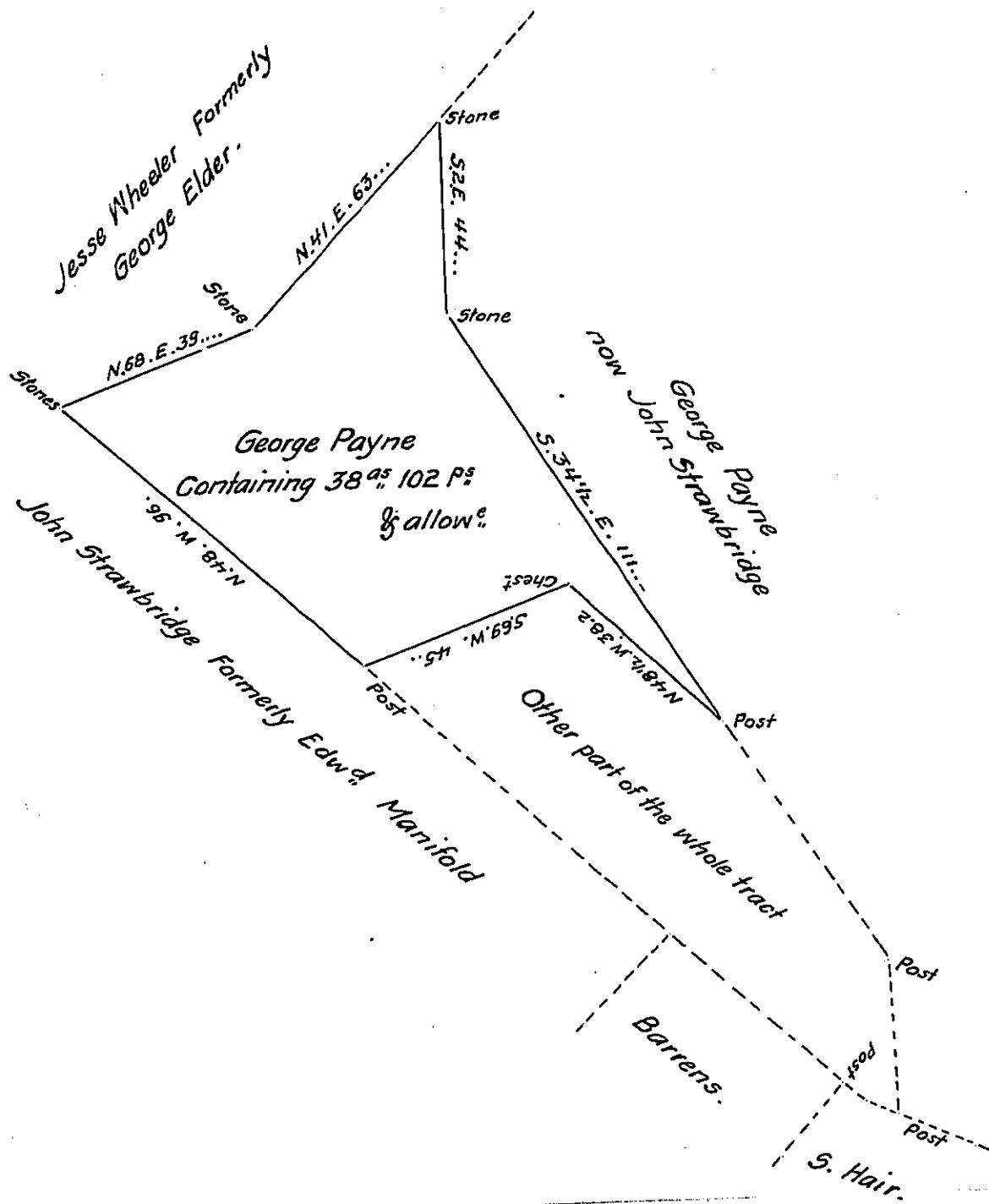


FORM NO 1.

N<sup>o</sup> 3155. dated the 23<sup>d</sup> day of March 1767. Resurveyed & Divided off from said larger tract of land the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 1827. at the request of John Strawbridge the present owner of said part who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
