 ed Tract Containing three hundred and eighteen Acres and one  
 Quarter of an Acre and Allowance of Six pr<sup>t</sup> Cent. Situate adjoining  
 Lands of Bernard Dougherty Esq<sup>r</sup> and others on the North  
 Side of Conemaugh including Sugar Tree Run in Wheatfield  
 Township Westmorland (now Indiana) County by Warrant of  
 the 14<sup>th</sup> March 1788. -

N.B. The above mentioned Warrant was Executed by Joshua  
 Elder at the time above Specified but was not Returned  
 to the Surveyor Generals Office, I did on the 23<sup>d</sup> March  
 1811 Trace the original Lines of Said Survey and find  
 them to be accurate and have now Returned it.
