



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the eleventh day of November 1785 the above described tract of two hundred & fifty acres of land & the allowe of six ~~per~~ cent. for roads No XXV situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany river in Westmoreland County.
