



IN PURSUANCE OF AN ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
OF PENNSYLVANIA PASSED THE 24TH DAY OF FEBRUARY 1785 ENTITLED
AN ACT FOR DIRECTING THE MODE OF DISTRIBUTING THE
DONATION LANDS PROMISED THE TROOPS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH
BY ORDER OF THE SURVEYOR GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL
OF THE HON^{BLE} THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL. I HAVE SUR-
VEYED ON THE ELEVENTH DAY OF NOVEMBER 1785 THE ABOVE
DESCRIBED TRACT OF TWO HUNDRED ACRES OF LAND & THE
ALLOWANCE OF SIX PER CENT FOR ROADS NO COOLXI SITUATE
IN DISTRICT NO 2 ON THE WEST SIDE OF ALLEGANY RIVER
IN WESTMORELAND COUNTY.
