

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops by this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land & allowance of six  $\frac{1}{4}$  cent for roads &c No CCXVIII situate in district No 2 on the west side of Alleghany river in Westmoreland County
