

In pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled, "An" Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands, "promised the troops by this Commonwealth;" and by order of the Surveyor General, with the approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1786, the above described tract of five hundred acres of land, and allowance for roads, &c., No 172, situate in district No. 2, on the west side of the Allegany River, in the county of Westmoreland.
