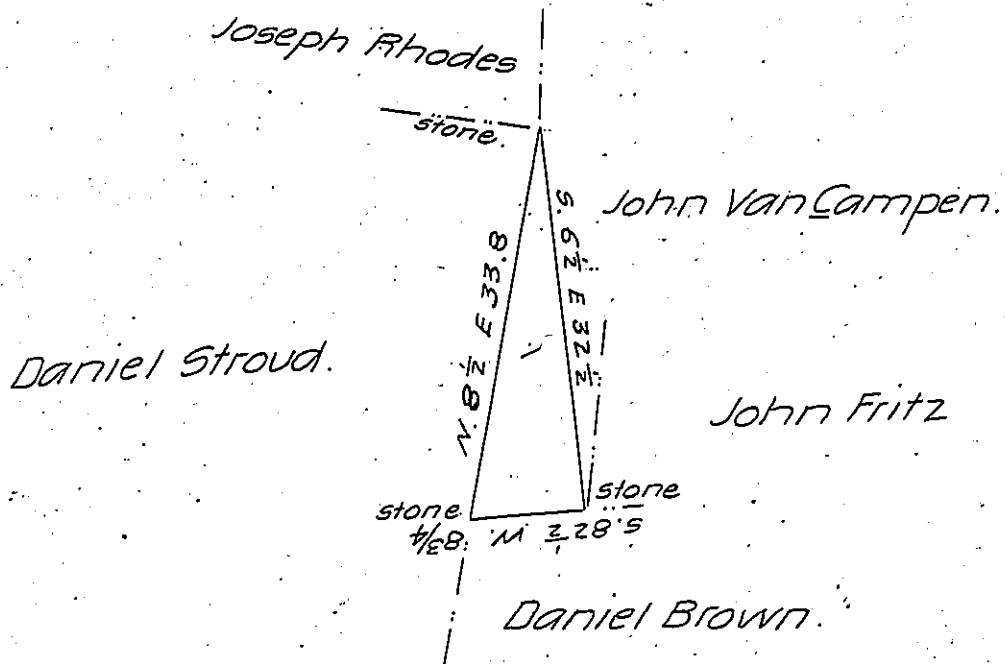


Del. - PIKE.

 Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> of March 1858 to Gilbert J. Steel the above tract  
 of land adjoining lands surveyed to Daniel Brown, John Fritz,  
 John Van Campen, Joseph Rhodes and Daniel Stroud, Situate  
 in Delaware Township in the County of Pike (being improved  
 said improvement having been made in January 1858) con-  
 taining one hundred and thirty four perches and the allowance  
 of six per cent for roads &c. Pt.
