



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11th day of April 1799, for selling certain Reserved tracts of land therein named, the Instructions of the (Late) Governor date the 14th day of May 1799, and the order of the Surveyor Genl dated the 18th day of May 1799, ^{Surveyed the 19th of September, 1799} the above reserved tracts called Erie No. 31 (now) Erie County, containing one hundred & twenty six acres & seventy perches, Strict Measure.
