



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April, 1799 for selling certain Reservations tracts of land therein named, the Instructions of the (Late) Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799, and order of the Surveyor Genl dated the 18th day of May, 1799. Surveyed the 16th day of September 1799, the above described tract of land being No. 64 of the Reserved tract called Erie (now) Erie County containing one hundred & three acres & ten perches, strict measure.
