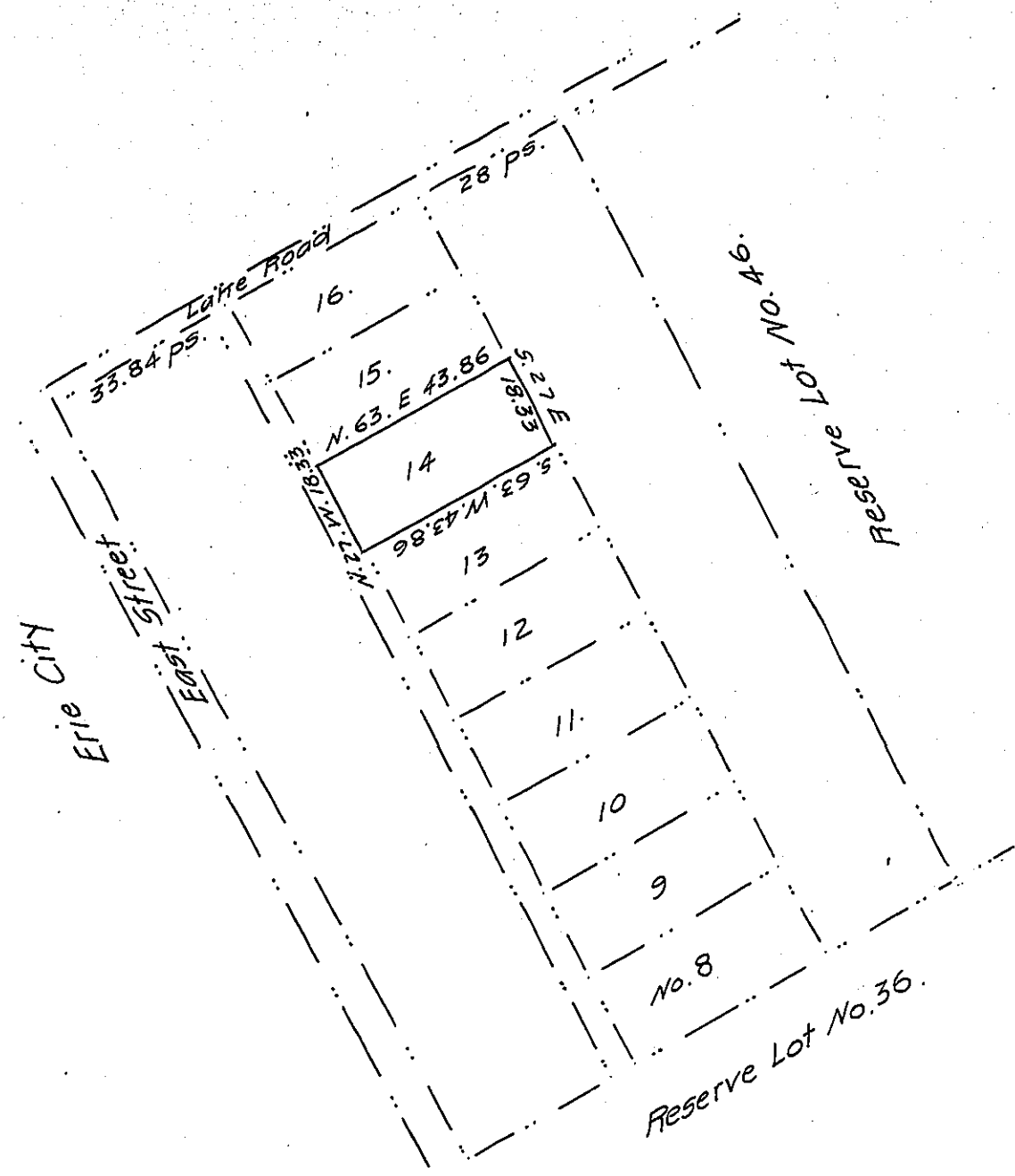

Beginning at the north west corner of Lot No. 14 in Brewster's subdivision of Reserve Tract No. 37, thence north 63° east 43.86 perches to west line of John Hess land, thence south 27° east by said Hess land 18.33 perches to a post, thence south 63° west 43.86 perches to a post, thence north 27° west 18.33 perches to the place of Beginning being subdivision No. 14 in Brewster's subdivision of Reserve Tract No. 37 adjoining the City of Erie
