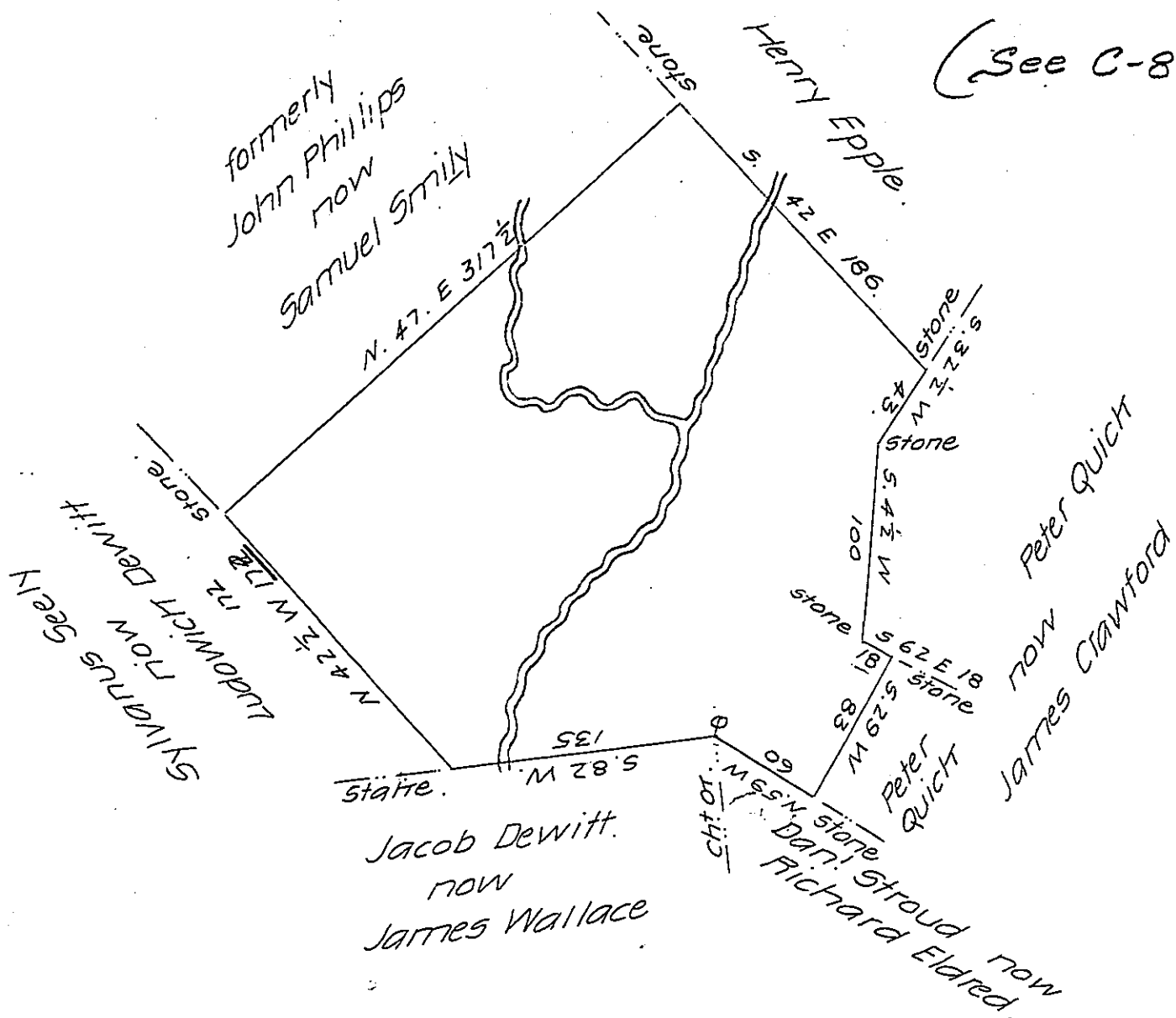

By virtue of a Warrant dated the 22d day of August 1793. Granted to Isaac Jones and order of Resurvey from Board of Property dated the 7th day of April 1845, granted to James Wallace, Surveyed the 29th day of April 1845 for James Wallace the above described tract of land Situate on the East Branch of Vandemark Creek adjoining land formerly known as John Phillips now Samuel Smiley, Sylvanus Seely now Ludowick Dewitt formerly in Uppersmithfield now Westfall Township late Northampton now Pike County, Containing four hundred & forty acres thirty three perches & allowance of six Pr. Ct.
