



By virtue of a warrant dated the 24th day of December 1823. Surveyed the 12th day of November 1824 the above described tract of land to Jesse McKane situate on the waters of the Reymans Hill and Saw Creek about five miles from the Town of Milford adjoining lands of Lute Brodhead, Abraham Shymer and others, including an improvement made in the fall of 1817 (as supposed). Containing three hundred and eighty two acres and seventy one perches and allow^e of 6 Pr. Ct. for roads &c.
