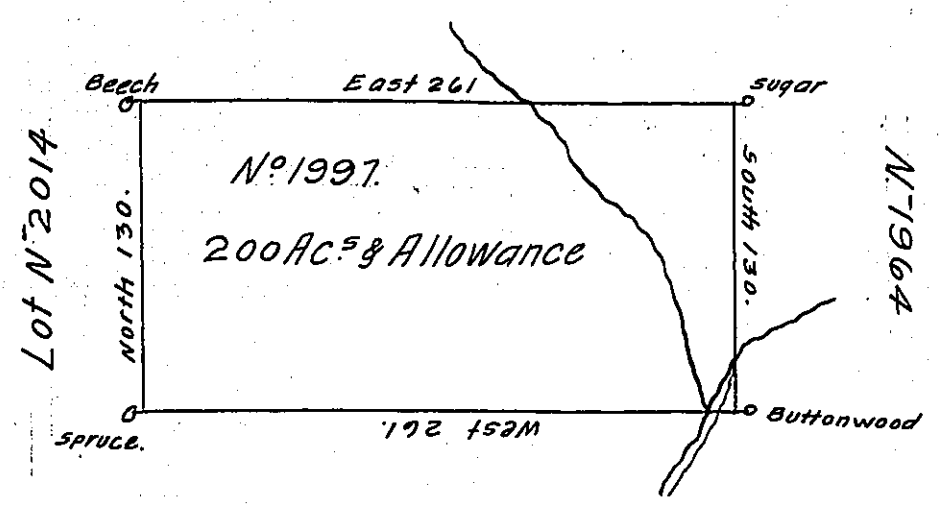

 of distributing the donation lands promised to the Troops of this Common-  
 wealth; And by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the  
 Hon<sup>ble</sup> Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785.  
 the above described tract of two hundred Acres and Allowance of  
 six & 7/8 Ct for roads &c.
