 granted to William Nyce and order of survey received the 6th  
 day of September 1843, Surveyed the 31st day of October 1843, the  
 above described tract of land situate on a branch of Saw Creek,  
 about two miles from Harmanus Brintis Saw Mill (formerly  
 in Upper Smithfield Township, Northampton Co) now Milford  
 Township Pike County, Containing two hundred and four acres  
 sixty one perches and allowance of Six Pct for roads &c.
