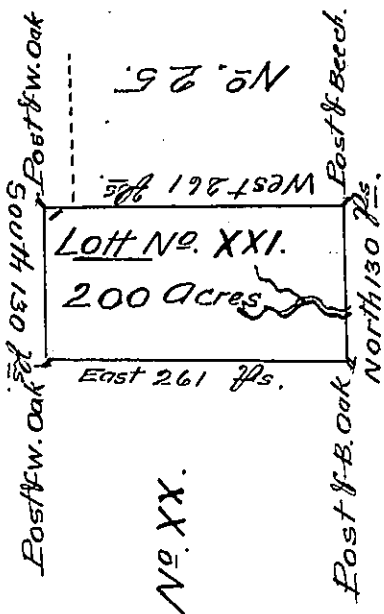

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the
State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February
1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of dis-
tributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of
this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor
General with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Su-
preme Executive Council I have surveyed on the 7th
day of October 1785, The above discribed Tract of
Two Hundered Acres of land and allowance of six
Cent for roads &c. No XXI. situate in District No. 1,
on the west side of the Allegany river, in the County of
Westmoreland.
