 surveyed on the First day of ^{November} ~~October~~ 1785, the above de-
 scribed Tract of Two Hundred acres of Land, and allowance
 of six per cent. for roads &c. No. CXXIX. situate in District
 No. 1. on the west side of the Allegany river, in the
 county of Westmoreland.
