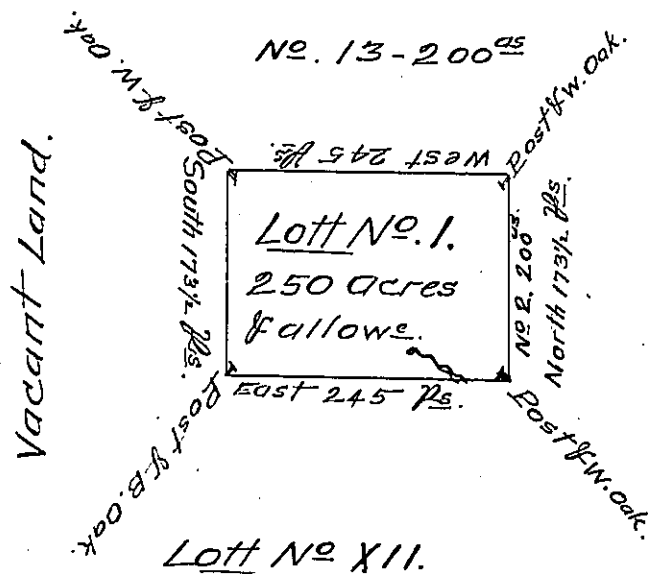


Joseph Morgan, Sergeant

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State  
of Pennsylvania, Passed the 24<sup>th</sup>. day of February 1785, en-  
titled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the  
donation lands promised the Troops of this Common-  
wealth," and by order of the Surveyor General with the  
approbation of the Honorable the Supreme Executive Coun-  
cil I have surveyed <sup>on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October</sup> the above discribed Tract of Two  
Hundred and fifty acres of Land and allowance of six  
P Cent. for roads &c. No. 1. situate in District No. 1.  
on the west side of the Alleganey river in The Coun-  
ty of Westmoreland.
