



Situate on the west side of Laurel Hill, in Union Township, Fayette County, Pa. surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1832, in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Joseph Downer for 150<sup>acs.</sup> dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1832.

There is about 4 or 5 acres of this tract in the state of cultivation, it was first cleared about the year 1798 or 1799, no house nor family on it.
