The red lines represent part of a survey made for Thomas Coles on Warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1784. This Survey interferes one hundred and forty two & one half acres with the David John Batchelor tract. Thomas Coles conveyed to Samuel Shannon who conveyed to Zacariah Lovel the present owner.
