



Application No. 4502, granted 17<sup>th</sup> October, 1767, to Sarah Trent for 300<sup>ac</sup> on the North branch of Middle Creek about 2 miles East from W<sup>m</sup> Wallace's Survey joining the North Mountain.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Application No. 4502, granted 17<sup>th</sup> October, 1767, to Sarah Trent for 300<sup>ac</sup> on the North branch of Middle Creek about 2 miles East from W<sup>m</sup> Wallace's survey. Joining the North Mountain, on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
