



Situate in Morris Township Huntingdon County was first Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> of September 1766 on an order of Survey Granted Oliver Wallace dated August first 1766. No. 535 P<sup>ts</sup> Richard Tea D.S. Resurvey'd June 13<sup>th</sup> 1791 and ninety four Acres 72 perches Struck off which belonged to the proprietary Manor by John Canan D.S. and now resurveyed and Divided between Casper Mogle and John Pottius the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1810.
