



Situate in Upper Mahoning Township Schuylkill County containing 104A 49E & allowance of Six per Cent for Roads & Surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1830. by Virtue of an Appl<sup>ca</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 440. — dated the 10 August A.D. 1765. entered by John Britton

To the Honble the Board of Property of Pennsylv<sup>a</sup> By Geo. Patin —

The above Survey was made in 1768. or 1769. as appears by the line trees on the ground. No Draught to shew the date Actual Survey — Present owners of Survey — Two Warrants were granted unto John Ox, one Peter Yoder, Esq. of them dated the 11 June 1816, and the other dated the 21 Jacob Ox — October 1816. both executed on the above ground and afterwards confirmed by a Patent. There was once an old improvement on the above tract but it is said the Indians drove off the said Settlers. when that was begun I cannot ascertain
