



Draught of a tract of Land in Quincy Township, Franklin County, Pa. Contain-
ing eight acres and and thirty seven perches and allowance of six per cent
for roads, &c. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Peter
Fries, dated May 5th, 1851, for eight acres of Land. Surveyed May 20th,
1851.

N.B. It appears the above land was once included in a Survey
made to Thomas Stoops, dated April 10th, 1794, (date of the war-
rant unknown) but abandoned by their successors, and has been
occupied by Jacob Kerbaugh, who held the adjoining tract (now
sold to Peter Fries) - for about fifty years.
