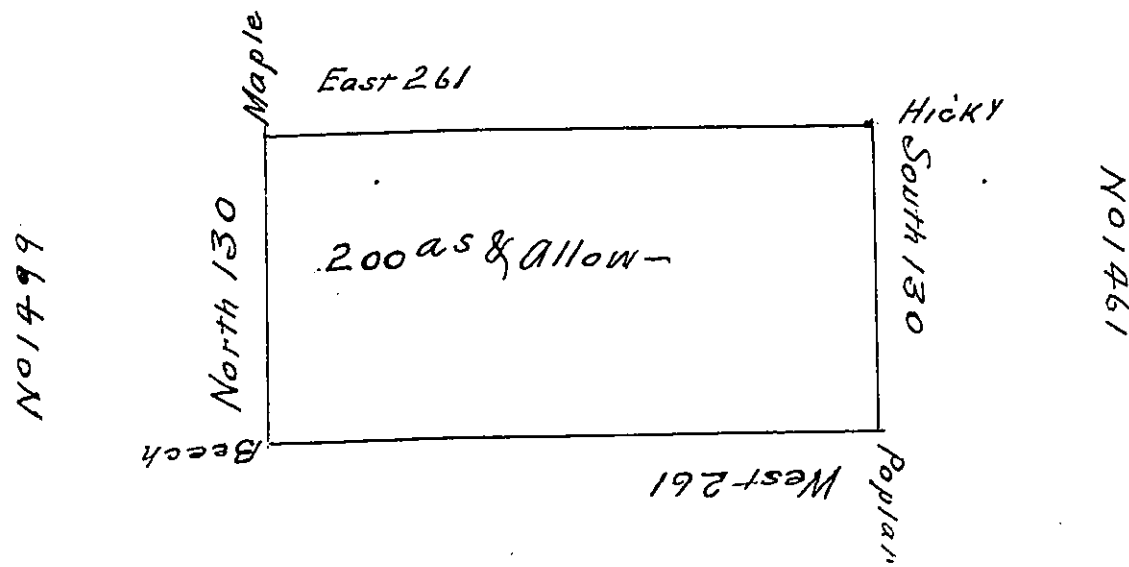

In pursuance of an Act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the State of Pennsylv-  
 -vania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, Intituled an act for  
 Directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised  
 to the Troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup>  
 With the approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> Executive Council, I have Surveyed  
 on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup>, 1785, the above described tract of Two  
 Hundred Acres & Allow: of 6 p Cent for roads &c  
 N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCLXXXVI. Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 7. on the West Side of the  
 Allegeny River in the County of Westmorland.
