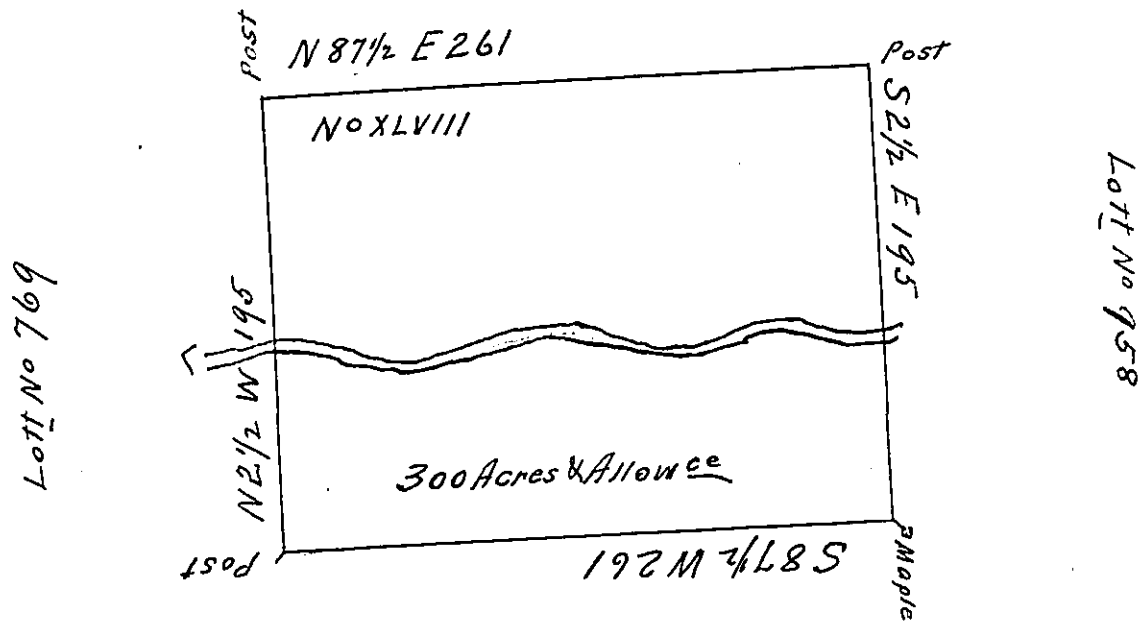

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised the Troops of this Commonwealth", and by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1785, the above described tract of Three Hundred Acres & allowance of Six per Cent, for roads &c, No XLVIII. Situate in District No. 5. on the West side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
