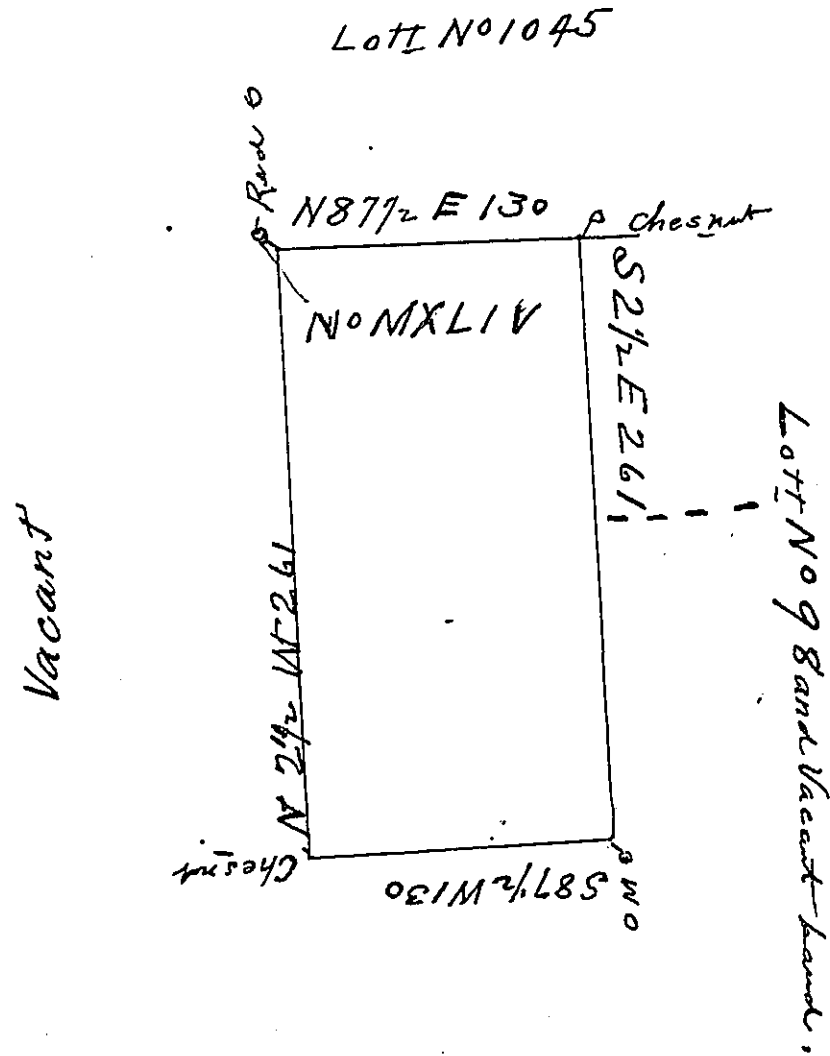

Council; I have Surveyed on the 25th day of October, 1785. the above

on the West side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
