



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24 day of February 1785 entitled, "An act for directing the Mode of distributing the donation lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth" And by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honble Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1785, the above described tract of five hundred Acres & Allowance of Six per cent for roads &c, No CXC1, Situate in district No 10, on the West Side of Alleghany river in the County of Westmoreland
