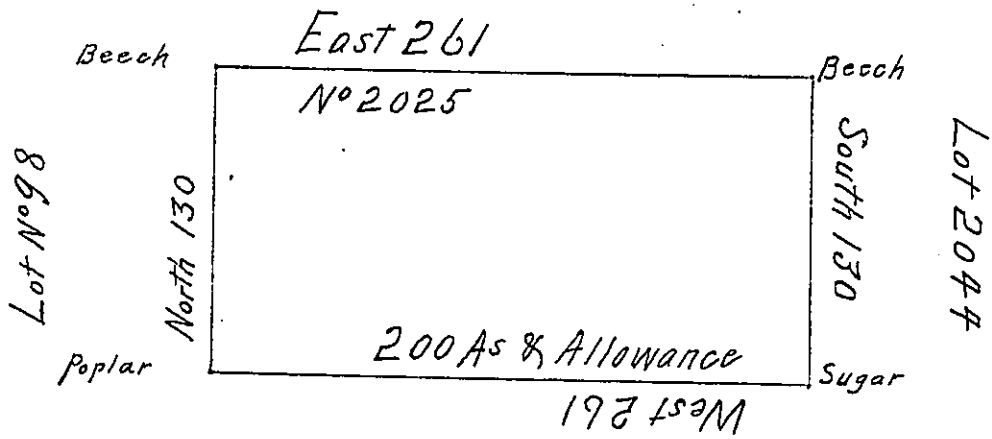

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24 day of February 1785 entitled a "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 26 day of July 1785 the above described tract of Two Hundred Acres and allowance of Six $\frac{1}{100}$ for roads & N° MMXXV Situate in district N° 10 on the West Side of Alleghany River in the County of Westmoreland.
